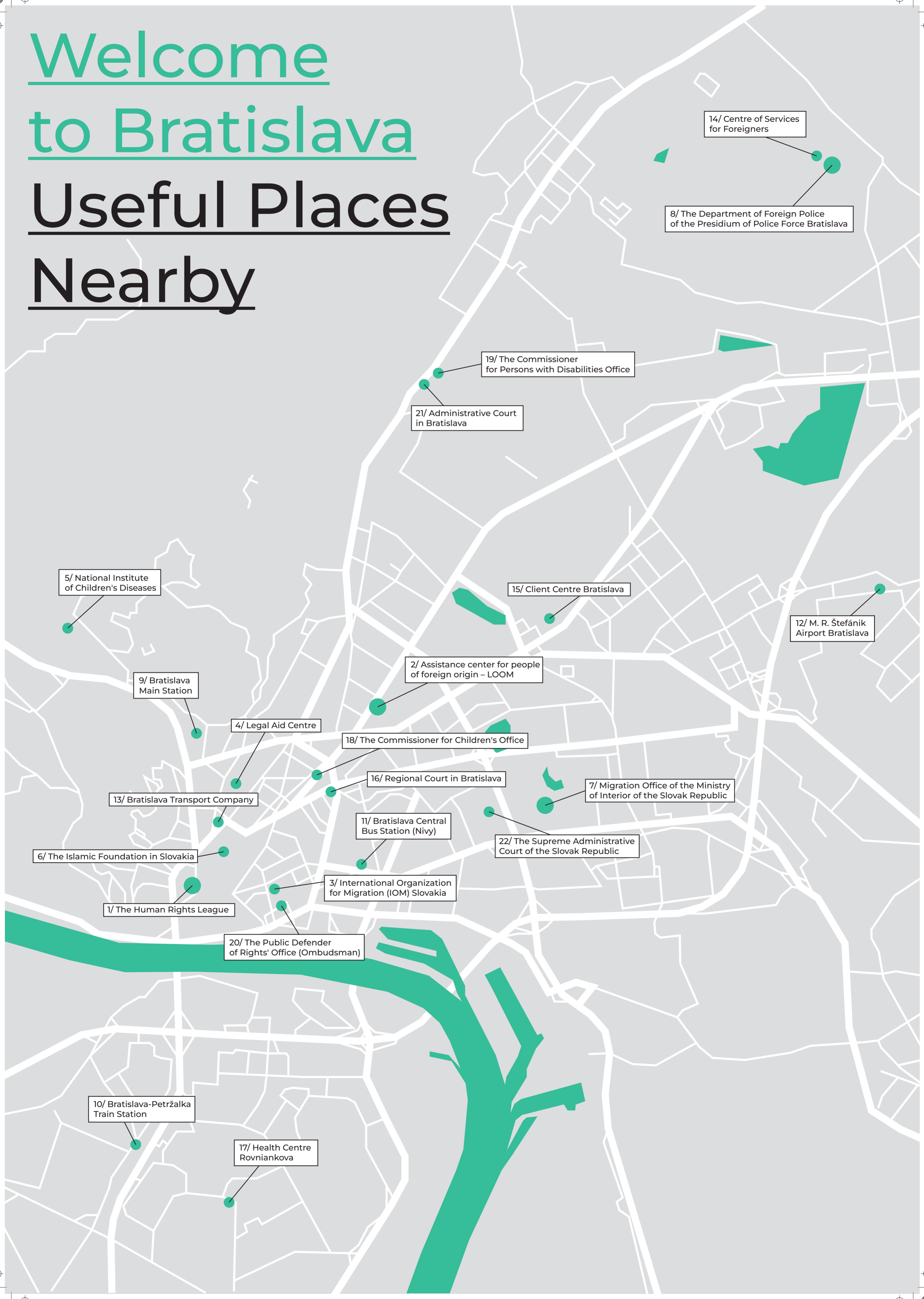

Services also encompass the issuance of necessary travel documents for foreigners and managing returns or expulsions.
