Hate Speech and Hate Crime

What is hate crime?

- ODHIR (OSCE): Hate crimes are **criminal acts** motivated by **bias or prejudice** towards particular groups of people.
- Bias motivations can be broadly defined as **preconceived negative opinions**, **stereotypical assumptions**, **intolerance or hatred directed to a particular group that shares a common characteristic**, such as race, ethnicity, language, religion, nationality, sexual orientation, gender or any other fundamental characteristic. People with disabilities may also be victims of hate crimes.
- Hate crimes can include threats, property damage, assault, murder or any other criminal offence committed with a bias motivation.







What is hate speech?

CoE: European Commission against Racism and Intolerance (ECRI):

- Hate speech covers many forms of expressions which spread, incite, promote or
 justify hatred, violence and discrimination against a person or group of persons for
 a variety of reasons.
- In Slovakia, several types of hate speech are sanctioned by criminal law.
- Slovakia also has "Framework to Fight Extremism 2015 2019" national policy document officially approved by Slovak Government
